

## Baptism Godparent Covenant for St. Boniface, Kersey

As a potential Godparent, your responsibility is to foster the faith of your Godchild and to reflect to your Godchild the meaning of life and of Catholic discipleship.

The Code of Canon Law (Church Law) specifies the requirements of serving as a Godparent (Canon 874): You may not be the parent of the person being baptized; you must be at least 16 years old; you must be fully initiated (having received Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist); and *if married*, be in a valid Catholic marriage (or not living with someone other than your valid Catholic spouse); and live a life of active faith in the Catholic Church.
